Update on Harding Building

We have moved PreK through grade 4 over to St. Peters Catholic Church on North Main Street. The flood damage is extensive in that we lost several computers, curriculum, and 2,700 of our library books. We will need to tear out all the carpets, paint the floor with industrial paint, paint the entire inside of the building, replace many bookshelves, replace the cabinets and flooring in the kitchen, tear out and replace the bottom two feet of sheetrock throughout the downstairs, tear out and replace insulation, fix wiring as well as upgrade our sewer drainage system to prevent this type of incident in the future. Our plan is to seal off the downstairs and bring the grade school back to the Harding building as quickly as possible once the upstairs has been given a clean bill of health by mold and air quality specialists. We are currently working on arrangements to accommodate KinderFun and the First Grade classes in our upstairs area until all the needed repairs are done.

Make Up Snow Days
