

## CSLA ROBOTICS TEAMS PERFORM WELL AT STATE TOURNAMENT

The CSLA Electric Lions and iPower Lego Robotic teams competed last weekend at the Intel Oregon *FIRST* Lego League Championship Tournament. Both teams did well and enjoyed the experience.

iPower came home with a 1st place trophy, The Bonneville Power Administration Project Award, for their Research Project. This award is presented to the team whose quality research, innovative solutions and creative presentation best reflects an in-depth understanding of the various scientific disciplines and issues involved with the Challenge Project.

*FIRST* (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) was founded in 1989 by inventor Dean Kamen to inspire young people's interest and participation in science and technology. Our CSLA teams this year designed and built robots using Legos and a NEXT computer Lego brick. The team also performed the computer programming of the robot; they programmed their robots to complete missions on a game field. Both teams performed very well.

The Electric Lions had the highest score at the local tournament and continued to carry one of the highest scores at the State Tournament.

In addition, teams were judged on their technical knowledge and their programming skills. The teams were also asked to look into alternative sources of energy and/or conservation of energy for their research this year. The Electric Lions did their research on the Newberg Public Library and the iPower team performed their research on the Grade School building. Teamwork was also a huge part of the program. Just like the real world, teams had to learn how to work together in order to accomplish goals, learning the important lesson that what we discover is more important than what we win.
