C.S. Lewis Academy receives \$12,000 grant

C.S. Lewis Academy has been selected to receive a \$12,000 grant from the Robles foundation.

\$5,000 will benefit CSLA's award winning Student Community Outreach Program (SCOP). For the past eleven years, CSLA students have gone out in the community on a quarterly basis, serving in soup kitchens, cleaning up local parks, doing yard work for the elderly, collecting food for FISH, building with Habitat for Humanity, helping out at Hamilton House, and much more. The objectives of this project are to develop in students a passion for community service and to encourage student leadership in community events.

\$4,000 will go to the CSLA Theater Arts Program. Even on a much smaller budget the CSLA Drama Department has been invited to represent our region of the state in the Oregon State Thespian Conference twice in the past four years. This honor is especially appreciated considering some competing schools have drama departments larger than the entire preK-12 CSLA student body. We are excited to see what this talented group can do with the newly enlarged budget.

The remaining \$3,000 will go toward general operating expenses. It is our hope that the procurement of these funds will not only support the growth of CSLA's award winning SCOP and Theater Arts programs, but that it will also encourage matching funds from other interested foundations. These grants will enable CSLA to take the next step in serving its students, families, and community.
