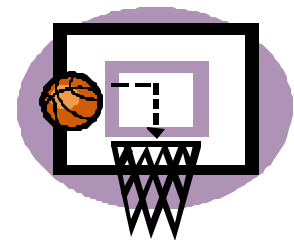
WYNOOSKI NEWS

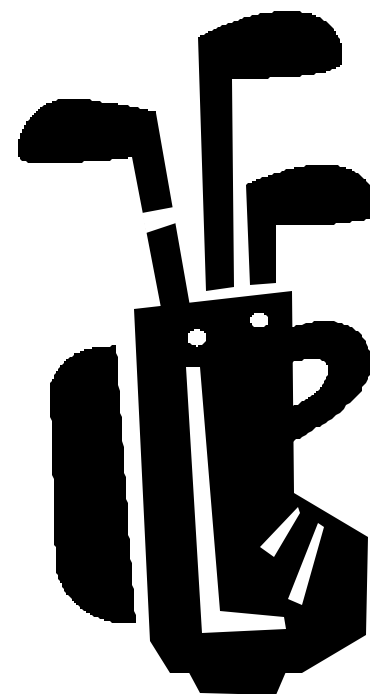
