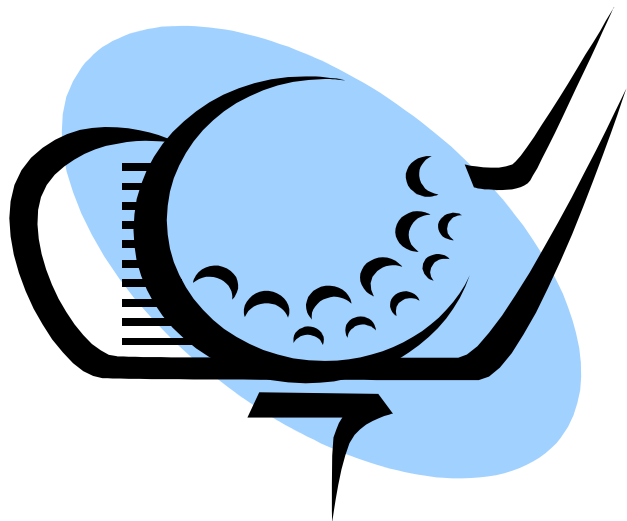


FUNDRAISING NEWS
