**REPORTS TO:** Athletics Director

**JOB GOAL:** To help each participating student achieve a high level of athletic skill, an appreciation for values of discipline, and an increased level of self-esteem.

**PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES (NOT NECESSARILY LIMITED TO):**

1. Teaches skills necessary for excellent achievement.
2. Conducts sports program according to knowledge of physical growth patterns and appropriate training methods for the age of the participants.
3. Plans and schedules a practice schedule in conjunctions with athletic director.
4. Maintains fair and consistent management and discipline of young athletes, making certain the participants know and understand the athletic code rules and other rules governing eligibility.
5. Demonstrates a positive model for participants, which include exemplary sportsmanship, respect for opponents, and officials, and high personal moral values.
6. Strives to motivate and achieve a positive, enthusiastic attitude among young athletes.
7. Conducts the program in accordance with C.S. Lewis Academy's philosophy and mission of "preparing students for life" as well as abiding by the district adopted policies and rules of OSAA.
8. Recommends purchase of equipment, supplies, and uniforms to the athletics director in accordance with CSLA budgeting procedures.
9. Oversees the safety conditions of the facility or area assigned and takes corrective action when threat of harm to a participant or spectator is immediately apparent.
